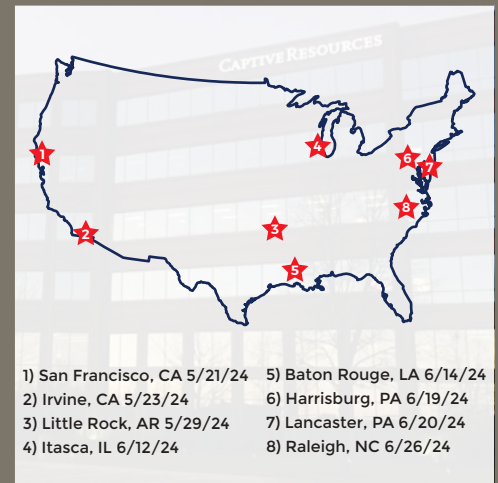

Session 1: OSHA Citations vs Actual Losses

How do your company's loss drivers compare to OSHA's most frequently cited violations? During this engaging session we'll take a (quick) look at OSHA's top 10 violations for the past five years to identify patterns and evaluate the historical appearance of these regulations on the frequency list. Thereafter, we'll look at the loss drivers for the captive membership as a whole and conduct a comparative analysis. Attendees leave the session with an understanding that, while regulatory compliance is a legal necessity, OSHA compliance should never be the sole metric for measuring success of a safety program.



Session 2: Safety Decision Making

How many safety contacts have reviewed an accident report, scratched their heads, and said, "How could this happen?" This is a frequent response to some of the more unique accident exposures (especially those which don't tie to an industry or company trend). In this presentation, we'll review the science behind decision making and apply it to the safety process.



Session 3: Ideas That Stick – How to Give Impactful Training Presentations

Why is it that our employees can remember lines from a movie they saw years ago, but they can't remember the valuable information delivered in workplace training? When training, we use various techniques for getting and keeping their attention, but it's worth working to make our ideas – the content itself – more sticky. Using the Heath brothers' six qualities as a jumping off point, we will discuss the principles that make your ideas stick: Simple, Unexpected, Concrete, Credible, Emotional, and Stories.



Session 4: Workplace Hazard Evaluation

To protect your employees, it is important to be able to identify and assess hazards in the workplace as they relate to your employees. It is important to know what to look for and how to rank hazards in the workplace, to help prioritize your focus and resources for hazard abatement.
